The capital, Saint-Denis, is typically French, but aside from the beaches, it's the unusual topography that entices: Reunion is full of freshwater lakes, rivers, waterfalls and other scenic splendours. Birdlife here is prolific, and whale watching a popular pastime between May and September. Famous sights include the three cirques, each unique and created by the volcanco that gave birth to this magnificent slice of paradise. A holiday here encompasses sampling fabulous French food, hiking, exploring the tiny French villages, paragliding over the mountainous regions or taking a helicopter flip over the volcano and lagoon.

DISCOVER REUNION - 7 NIGHTS

Salazie Caldera | Fournaise's Volcano | Wild South | West Coast



Day 1 Arrive at Roland Garros Airport, collect your rental car and depart for St Denis, the island's capital. **Overnight at St Denis**

Day 2 Depart for Hell-Bourg, a typical Creole village in Salazie Caldera. En route to the Vanilleraie, discover the exciting story of Bourbon Vanilla in Le Grand Hazier. Visit the waterfalls. **Overnight at Salazie**

Day 3 Drive through the Wild South past fascinating sites like the Notre Dame des Laves (Lady of the Lava) and Anse des Cascades (waterfalls). Walk along the lava road, passing the Piton de la Fournaise. Stop by Jardin des Parfums et des Epices, a garden of perfumes and spices. Explore the beautiful viewpoint of Cap Mechant. **Overnight at St Pierre**

Day 4 Depart for the volcano, Le Piton de la Fournaise, to view its craters. It's the perfect location for hiking and exploring the moon-like landscape. Stop at the Hydraulic Clock at La Llaine des Cafres for a superb view point of Grand Bassin. **Overnight at St Pierre**

Day 5 Depart early for Cilaos and drive to the heart of the Caldera. Stop at the la Roche Merveilleuse (Wonderful Rock), for panoramic views. Explore the village, and visit the thermal sources. **Overnight at Cilaos**

Day 6 Make your way to l'Etang-Sale to admire the black volcanic sand beach. Head to St Leu on the coastal road from St Leu to La Saline. Spend a relaxing evening at **Overnight at L'Ermitage**

Day 7 Enjoy the day at leisure. If you like, take a helicopter flip over the Island. **Overnight at L'Ermitage**

Day 8 Check out and return to the airport.



NORTHERN ISLAND EXPLORER - 7 NIGHTS

Salazie Caldera | Fournaise's Volcano



+ TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Vanilla plantation | Salazie, the greenest of the 3 Cirques | Drive to St Philippe to see the lava | Visit a Turtle farm in Kelonia | Stroll through the beautiful village of Hell-Bourg

Day 1 On arrival you will be met by a Thompsons representative. Collect your rental car and take the short drive to St Denis. **Overnight St Denis**

Day 2 Travel inland to Salazie, the largest and greenest of the three cirques. Spend the night in Hell-bourg, located at the bottom of the cirque. **Overnight in Hell-Bourg**

Day 3 Head off to St Anne on the picturesque coastal road. En route, stop in Bras Panon to visit the local Vanilla manufacturing plant. After the tour enjoy lunch at the onsite Le Vani-La Restaurant. **Overnight St Anne**

Day 4 We suggest that you make an early start to visit the island's legendary active volcano, Piton de la Fournaise, which is about a 2.5 hour drive away. You spend the following 4 nights in the charming seaside village of **St Gilles**

Day 5 Drive inland to Le Maido, through dense cryptomeria forests. This breathtaking view site overlooks another caldera called the Cirque of Mafate. There are many activities on offer in the area, including quadbiking, horse riding, tree-climbing as well as various arts and crafts stalls along the way. Take time to visit the bustling market at St Paul (open Fridays & Saturdays). **Overnight St Gilles**

Day 6 After a leisurely breakfast, take a short drive to Saint Leu to visit the turtle research institute at Kelonia. For lunch, we suggest La Villa la Vanille. **Overnight St Gilles**

Day 7 At leisure in St. Gilles to enjoy the magnificent white beaches and the many sporting activities on offer. **Overnight St Gilles**

Day 8 Time to check out and return to the airport.

COASTAL & INLAND EXPLORER - 7 NIGHTS

St Denis | St Pierre | St Gilles

Day 1 You are met by a Thompsons representative. Collect your rental car and drive to St Denis, the island's capital. **Overight St Denis**

Day 2 En route to Hell-Bourg, visit La Vanilla plantation – an authentic Creole farm. Travel on to the Salazie caldera, formed by a dormant volcano with clear streams and waterfalls. View the Veil of the Bride, the island's most beautiful waterfall. Enjoy a traditional Creole lunch at Le Jardin d'Héva. After lunch, visit the Folio house. Overnight Salazie

Day 3 Le Piton de la Fournaise is the only active volcano on the island. A winding road takes you to Le pas de Bellecombe for breathtaking views of the volcano. Have lunch at le Bardot, a traditional Creole restaurant. Drive to St Pierre, the capital of the south. Overnight St Pierre

Day 4 Visit the volcano, estimated to be 50,000 years old. Have lunch at le Baril, a Creole restaurant. Return to St Pierre. Overnight St Pierre

Day 5 Enjoy one of the most scenic drives on Reunion Island. Continue to La Roche Merveilleuse, a natural viewpoint with panoramic views of Cilaos. Have lunch at Le Sentier or Le Petit Randonneur. Overnight Cilaos

Day 6 Take a stop at La Saga du Rhum Museum. In the afternoon, drive to St Gilles and the village of Ermitage. Overnight L'Ermitage

Day 7 Enjoy the day at leisure. Take a helicopter ride above the island. The best scenery on Reunion is in its wild interior, deep canyons and calderas, waterfalls, and the volcano. Overnight St Gilles

Day 8 Check out and return to the airport



INTREPID HIKERS' TRIP – 5 NIGHTS

Salazie | Piton De La Fournaise | Wild South | West Coast





+ TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Visit a local vanilla plantation | Explore Salazie, the greenest of the 3 Cirques | Drive to St Philippe to see the lava | Visit the Turtle farm in Kelonia | Stroll through the beautiful village of Hell-Bourg

Day 1 You will be collected from the airport and will travel in the direction of Salazie and the village of Hell-Bourg. Check into your hotel. **Overnight** Salazie

Day 2 Visit the village and Villa Folio before you hike to la Nouvelle with lunch at your own account. Overnight at Relais de Mafate

Day 3 Trek up to Marla on the 2.5 hour hike. Stop for lunch at your own account. Overnight at Marla

Day 4 Trek back to Col des Boeufs with lunch at your own account. This hike is 5.5 hours long and covers 7km. **Transfer to St Gilles for overnight**

Day 5 Day at leisure to explore St Gilles. Why not take a helicopter tour for an aerial view of St Paul, Mafate Caldena, Salazie and the Trou de Fer Waterfall. Explore the lagoon via kayak or quad bike through the forest





GREAT SIGHTSEEING OPTIONS

THE MAIDO & ST PAUL MARKET

Stop at 'Maido', an incredible viewpoint at an altitude of 2,200m overlooking the cirque of Mafate, a caldera (collapsed former volcano). Explore St Paul Market, which offers a fabulous experience filled with unique flavours and extraordinary local scents. The market offers crafts as well as numerous exotic spices, succulent tropical fruits and countless varieties of vegetables.



OUADBIKING

Take an adventurous trip down a mountainside on a specially adapted four-wheeled quadbike, which is unique to the island. No experience is required and you are accompanied by a guide. This is the most fun you can have on a bike using just pedal power! Enjoy the magnificent scenery and stunning sea views as you descend.

VOLCANIC EXPLORER

Depart for Piton de la Fournaise, considered the most active volcano on the planet. The drive takes you to the high plains of La plaine des Cafres, a cool, lush landscape where the island's bovine industry is most active. First stop is at the Nez de Boeuf, an incredible viewpoint at an altitude of 2,070m looking down into the caldera called la Rivière des Rampart.



SALAZIE LUXURIANCE & WATERFALLS

Head for the north of the island, passing through the capital, St Denis. Continue on until you reach the east side of Reunion, famous for its sugar cane plantations. Stop at the spectacular Niagara waterfalls in Saint Suzanne, then visit the vanilla plantation to discover how the amazing vanilla flowers are reared by hand pollination.

PARAGLIDING

Take to the skies for a magnificent view over the entire west of the island. You'll see the primary forest of upper St Leu and then, facing the Indian Ocean, you will extend your flight through the first thermals. Seeing the lagoon and the turtles is included in the programme, after which you land on the beach.



CILAOS LANDSCAPES & RAMPARTS

Depart for the southern part of Reunion. Drive through the village of la Rivière Saint Louis, then cross the Saint Etienne River on a road known as the '400 Turns'. The village of Cilaos is at an altitude of 1,300m, situated in one of the island's three calderas.



Admire the spectacular sunset over the Indian Ocean on a 1.5 hour cruise along Reunion's west coast. View the soaring peaks of the island as they change colour and mood in the fading light. Cocktail punch and juice is served as well as a variety of delicious Creole snacks.



HELICOPTER FLIPS

Your helicopter ride takes you to explore the three cirgues, the Iron Hole, the volcano and the island's west coast. Explore this colourful island with a bird's eye view of its crescent-shaped scenery created by a volcano that is one of the most active on earth. View the cirques in all their glory: Salazie with its luxuriant flora, Cilaos and its incredibly steep ramparts, Belouve/Bebour and its primary forest. Fly over the beaches, the lagoon with its exquisite coral reef, and the impressive waterfall in the Iron Hole, where, if you're lucky, you will see a beautiful rainbow.

CUISINE



Reunion's cuisine is as varied as it is delicious. It blends the diverse cultures that inhabit the island and combines French, African, Indian and Chinese traditions. Reunion's most iconic dish is called 'cari', a tasty combination of tomatoes, onions, turmeric, local saffron (stronger than its European counterparts) and ginger. It's served with rice, French beans, lentils, spinach with herbs and an accompaniment that is called 'rougail'.



Rum

Called 'rhum Charrette' it's named after its label that shows a cart loaded with sugar cane, drawn by an ox. It's produced from sugar cane or molasses.


Coffee

Coffee is a delicacy. Originally from Ethiopia, it was brought from Yemen to Reunion. It is called Bourbon Pointu and is one of the best and most expensive coffees in the world, a blend favoured worldwide by Michelin-starred chefs.


Bourbon Beer
