Historically the Nile cruise was really the only way to visit the temples and tombs located along this stretch of the river. Nile cruises visit a wide variety of antiquities along the banks of the river. It is a wonderful experience to sit on a shaded deck of a floating hotel, sipping an iced beverage while watching 5,000 years of culture slowly drift by.

### Getting There

The Red Sea is renowned as one of the world's best diving spots. Each Red Sea resort has a different character and there is something for everyone and to suite every kind of budget.

Egypt Air flies into Cairo and has good connections to all destinations within Egypt. Flying time is 8 & ½ hrs to Cairo.

### Cairo Sightseeing

#### Full Day Museum, Pyramids & Sphinx

The Egyptian Museum has the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities anywhere in the world. It features artefacts from the Pharaonic and Greco-Roman periods, including the celebrated mummies of ancient Egypt's Kings and Tutankhamun's treasures. The pyramids of Cheops, Chephren and Mycerinus, were considered by the Greeks, as one of the Seven Wonders of the World. In the face of such immensity, one cannot help but feel the wonder and awe that so many writers and artists have sought to convey over the centuries. The Cheops Pyramid is especially interesting, since its interior burial chambers are open for inspection by the public. Not far from the Pyramids is the Great Sphinx of Giza, which dates from the time of Chephren (2620 BC).

Half Day Citadel, Mosque & Bazaar

The tour begins with a visit to the Citadel, one of Cairo's most popular tourist attractions. The Citadel is one of the world's greatest monuments to medieval warfare, as well as a highly visible landmark on Cairo's eastern skyline. Facing the Citadel is the Mosque of Sultan Hassan, built between 1356 and 1363 and perhaps the most majestic monument of Arabic architecture in Egypt. The tour also includes a visit to Khan El Khalili, a famous Cairo Bazaar dating back to the late 14th century. Flying time is 8 & ½ hrs to Cairo.

### BEST TIME TO TRAVEL

### Greco Roman Museum

The Greco-Roman Museum has a vast collection of antiquities from the Pharaonic, Ptolemaic, Roman and Christian periods. It was first built in 1892, as a small building located on Horeya Road. In 1895 it was transferred to its present site and has gradually been enlarged in later renovation stages. Guests will also visit Pompey's Pillar, which is a column of red Aswan granite standing some 30 feet high, with a circumference of 27 feet. It was erected in honour of the Emperor Diocletian, and is the tallest ancient monument in Alexandria. The Catacombs are an extensive, three level/funerary probably dating from the 2nd century AD and are fascinating to visit.



**BEST TIME TO TRAVEL**

Conditions are perfect between Easter and mid-June - beaches and ancient sites are relatively uncrowded, accommodation is cheaper and easier to find than in the high season. Conditions are ideal from the end of August until mid-October, as the season winds down. Winter is not a viable period to visit outside the major cities and mainland as most of the tourist infrastructure on the islands goes into hibernation from the middle of October till the beginning of April.

**Getting There**  
Olympic Airlines flies into Athens and has good connections to all destinations within Greece. Flying time is 9hrs to Athens.

**Traveller's Tip**






